


Simon (S.I.O. Sounds It Out)




Word Talk

Sentence Master

The Sentence Master guarantees success for children who are at risk of reading failure due to difficulties in phonics, oral language, and/or impulsive learning styles. It avoids the confusing rules of phonics and the complexity of whole language by focusing on the most frequently-used words of our language (i.e. "the" "is" "but," "and," etc.) Learning these "little words" gives students control over the majority of text they will encounter.
